ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE
AND
GRANTING ALTERNATIVE SERVICE
AND SERVICE BY PUBLICATION**

The Court being in receipt of Plaintiff's Application for Order to Show Cause and for Order Granting Alternative Service or Service by Publication, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants appear before this Court on _____ at _____ to show cause, if any, why the Court should not direct the clerk to issue a subpoena under Rule 45 for a reasonable inspection of Maricopa County's mail-in ballots, specifically

1 including their signed envelopes (and/or scans thereof) and of the county's signatures on file for
2 comparison; and to compare "duplicate" ballots to the original ballots from which they were
3 "duplicated," for Congressional District 5 and Queen Creek in particular.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff's request for service by publication in
5 accordance with Rule 27(a)(3) is granted. Plaintiff shall publish the summons and a statement
6 describing how a copy of the pleadings may be obtained in a newspaper published in this
7 county. Service is complete once the summons and statement is published. Plaintiff shall also
8 mail to Defendants a summons and copy of the pleadings, postage prepaid. Plaintiff shall also
9 file a declaration stating the manner and dates of the publication and mailing and the
10 circumstances warranting service by publication. If no mailing was made because the Plaintiff
11 does not know the current address of the person being served, the declaration must state that
12 fact. A printed copy of the publication must accompany the declaration.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff's request for alternative service is granted.
14 Plaintiff may serve Defendants by mailing copies of the summons, pleadings, and this Order to
15 the Defendants' last-known address, and by posting a copy of the summons, pleadings and this
16 Order on a publicly-accessible website.
